Contact your site Title I & IV Coordinator

Title I Coordinators have funding to support effective, evidence-based educational programs that close the achievement gap and enable students to meet the state's challenging academic standards. Your Title I Coordinator will need a quote and a rationale that shows how Quindew will help your students meet their standards-based goals (or SMART goals) for the year.

Contact your site or district EL Administrator/Coordinator

Title III funding is designed to ensure that English learners (ELs) attain English language proficiency and meet state academic standards for reading, speaking, and writing. Federal funding is provided through various grant programs to assist state education agencies (SEAs) and local education agencies (LEAs) in accomplishing this. Your Title III administrator (who might be your site EL Coordinator) will need a quote and a rationale that shows how QuindewEL will help your students meet English language standards and state standards for reading.
